Churchill Way

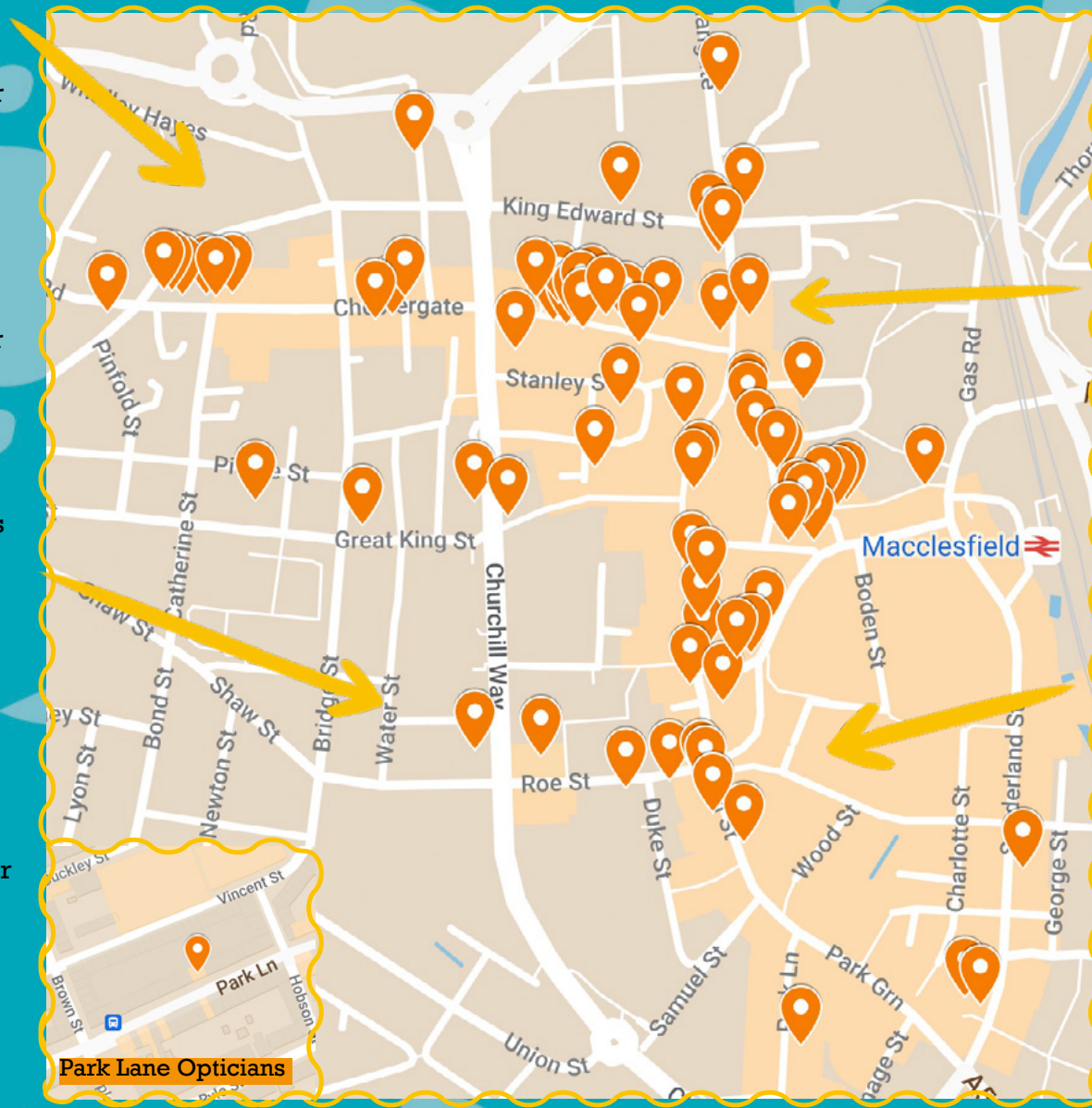
